Fruit Trees



Fruit	Variety	Size/Price	Description
Avocado	Hass	Fruit Tree \$29.95	Popular variety due to its superior taste and excellent keeping qualities. Medium sized pear-shaped fruit, excellent creamy nut flavoured flesh, no fibre. Mid to late season.
Avocado	Sharwill	Fruit Tree \$29.95	A medium sized fruit with rough green skin. The fruit has a rich flavour, good oil content and small seed. Mid season.
Avocado	Shepard	Fruit Tree \$29.95	Small to medium pear-shaped fruit with thick green skin that peels easily. Excellent flavour, medium oil content, does not turn brown when cut. Spreading habit, high yielding. Early to mid season.
Avocado	Wertz (compact)	Fruit Tree \$29.95	Smooth, thick, dark-green green skin that peels easily. The flesh is a pale yellow with a tinge of green. The tree is a bit smaller than other avocados.
Citrus dual graft	Dual Citrus Trees	Fruit Tree \$29.95	Combination of citrus varieties grafted on same tree.
Grapefruit	Rio Red	Fruit Tree \$24.95	Has less colour than Star Ruby and the colour of fruit on individual trees can vary. Needs to be harvested soon after maturity.
Grapefruit	Star Ruby	Fruit Tree \$24.95	Medium sized seedless fruit, smooth thin peel with dark red flesh, excellent quality. Harder to grow than other varieties. Early season.
Lemon	Eureka	Fruit Tree \$24.95	Probably the most widely grown lemon in the world. It's a true lemon with high juice and acid content. Thin-skinned and virtually seedless.
Lemon	Lisbon	Fruit Tree \$24.95	Smooth skinned, large, juicy bitter lemon produced on a thorny tree. Most of the year.
Lemon	Meyer	Fruit Tree \$24.95	Natural hybrid between a lemon and an orange. Orange coloured fruit with a thin rind. Juicy and less acid than other lemons. Fruits more than once a year. Ideal for growing in pots.

Fruit	Variety	Size/Price	Description
Lemonade	Citrus limon x reticulata	Fruit Tree \$24.95	Cross between Mandarin and Lemon. Sweet juicy fruit tastes like lemonade, devoid of bitterness and can easily be eaten as a fresh fruit. The lemonade tree often bears several crops each year.
Lime	Tahiti	Fruit Tree \$24.95	Small to medium fruit, pale yellow, smooth skin. Translucent pale green flesh, tender and juicy with a true acid lime flavour. Best to pick fruit green as it can suffer from rot if left to ripen on the tree. Fruits more than once a year.
Mandarin	Emperor	Fruit Tree \$24.95	Large, very juicy fruit. Loose skinned with a good flavour. Fruits end of July, mid-late season.
Mandarin	Glen Retreat	Fruit Tree \$24.95	Highly popular in Queensland with medium to large, superior quality fruit. Tree is vigorous, medium to large, upright-spreading, virtually thornless, with dense foliage.
Mandarin	Imperial	Fruit Tree \$24.95	Fruit has excellent colour and flavour. Skin is smooth, glossy, thin and semi-loose. Early season.
Mandarin	Page	Fruit Tree \$24.95	Cross between a tangelo and a mandarin. Medium size fruit, easily peeled, deep orange flesh colour, juicy, seedless.
Mango	Kensington Pride (Bowen)	Fruit Tree \$24.95	Most common variety grown due to its excellent quality fruit. Excellent flavour, very juicy and aromatic. Grafted form of the Bowen mango.
Mango	Nam Doc Mai	Fruit Tree \$24.95	Thai type mango. Green-yellow skin, sweet and juicy with an excellent flavour. This thin mango tree likes growing in coastal areas.
Mango	R2E2	Fruit Tree \$24.95	Mid-season variety with large, highly-coloured fruit. The second most popular mango variety grown. Mature fruit is beautifully yellow with a strong red blush and firm, non-fibrous flesh.
Navel Orange	Washington	Fruit Tree \$24.95	Main navel variety grown in Australia. Excellent skin colour and taste, round seedless fruit. Mid-season.

Fruit	Variety	Size/Price	Description
Orange	Late Valencia	Fruit Tree \$24.95	Large, oblong, firm fruit with a good flavour. Very juicy. Holds well on the tree. Late season.
Passionfruit	Panama	Fruit Tree \$12.95	Commercial passion fruit variety with purple fruit. Highly suited to tropical climate. Climber. Needs good drainage and full sun. Cutting grown.
Pomelo	Pink	Fruit Tree \$24.95	Tropical citrus fruit with large thick skin. Similar to a grapefruit although sweeter and far less cold tolerant.
Tangelo	Citrus x. tangelo	Fruit Tree \$24.95	The tangelo is a citrus hybrid between tangerine and grapefruit. The fruits are the size of an adult fist and have a tangerine taste, but are very juicy and have loose skin.
