Name		Size/Price	Description
<b>Acalypha lyonsii</b>	Native Acalypha	200mm \$19.90	Small, attractive, very hardy shrub with tiny, serrated leaves. Prune to thicken up for the first year. Ideal fill in plant. (Euphorbiaceae)
<b>Baeckea virgata</b>	Heath Myrtle	200mm \$18.50	Medium shrub with weeping form, fine foliage and dainty white flowers. Tolerates part shade and heavy pruning. (Myrtaceae)
<b>Bambusa arnhemica</b>		200mm \$18.50	(Poaceae)
<b>Banksia spinulosa</b>	Hairpin Banksia	200mm \$25.00	Small shrub. Dense habit with spectacular large gold Banksia flowers. Best in full sun. Suitable for most areas. (Proteaceae)
<b>Barringtonia calyptata</b>	Mango Pine	200mm \$19.90	Very handsome tree with large leaves and huge racemes of fluffy white flowers that attract birds. (Lecythidaceae)
<b>Breynia sp. Iron Range</b>	Red Coffee-Bush	200mm \$18.50	Shrub with red new growth and masses of small red berries. Food plant of Common Grass Yellow Butterfly. (Phyllanthaceae)
<b>Callistemon "Cameo Pink"</b>	Cameo Pink	200mm \$19.90	Medium shrub with attractive rose pink flowers. Does best in full sun. Usually frost resistant. (Myrtaceae)
<b>Callistemon "Dawson River"</b>	Dawson River	200mm \$19.90	Tall weeping shrub with red flowers. Attractive to birds. Very hardy. Will tolerate both wet and dry conditions. Can be pruned to act as a screening plant. (Myrtaceae)
<b>Callistemon "Eureka"</b>	Eureka	200mm \$19.90	Tall upright shrub with brilliant purple flowers in profusion in spring. Showy pink new growth. Suitable for screening. (Myrtaceae)
<b>Callistemon "Pindi Pindi"</b>	Pindi Pindi	200mm \$19.90	Medium to large shrub with attractive semi-weeping habit. Red flowers. Very hardy. Does best in full sun. Suitable for most areas. (Myrtaceae)
<b>Callistemon "Prolific"</b>	Prolific	200mm \$19.90	Large shrub with dense foliage. Ideal for use as a screen plant. Large red flowers for most of the year. Suitable for most areas. (Myrtaceae)

Name		Size/Price	Description
<b>Callistemon "White Anzac"</b>	White Anzac	200mm \$19.90	Small shrub. Bright green foliage with white flowers. (Myrtaceae)
<b>Callistemon "Wildfire"</b>	Wildfire	200mm \$19.90	Medium shrub. Dense foliage and large bright red flowers. Does best in full sun. Makes a good screen. (Myrtaceae)
<b>Carmona retusa</b>	Carmona	200mm \$25.00	Small shrub with dark green, stiff foliage and small white flowers on arching twigs. Very hardy. Full sun or part shade. (Boraginaceae)
<b>Carnarvonia montana</b>	Red Silky Oak	200mm \$25.00	Beautiful large shrub or small tree with unusual compound leaves. Fantastic foliage with very showy rusty brown new growth. Ideal tub plant. (Proteaceae)
<b>Curculigo recurvata</b>	Weevil Lily	200mm \$25.00	A short, stout herbaceous plant with a lily-like or palm-like appearance. Broad strap-like leaves. Flowers on erect heads. (Hypoxidaceae)
<b>Cyathea cooperi</b>	Common or Lacy Treefern	200mm \$19.90	Fast growing hardy tree fern. Slender trunk with crown of bright green fronds to 2 metres long. Takes full sun in moist areas. (Cyatheaceae)
<b>Dendrobium mixed native species and hybrids</b>	Mixed Dendrobium orchids	50mm \$8.90	Challenging but highly attractive indigenous orchids from eastern Australia. Place in an airy position off the ground, with some light shading during summer, and keep moist all year round. (Orchidaceae)
<b>Eucryphia wilkiei</b>	Wilkie's Eucryphia	200mm \$35.00	A very rare shrub from very high altitude NQ rainforests. Unusual greyish foliage and large, white, rose-like flowers with an unusual fragrance that are very attractive to birds. Suited to high rainfall areas. (Cunoniaceae)
<b>Gossia inophloia "Red"</b>	Blushing Beauty	200mm \$18.50	Bushy shrub with dark burgundy new growth for most of the year. Small fruit from white flowers in summer are bird-attracting. Can tolerate light frosts. Can be grown in full sun or semi-shade. (Myrtaceae)
<b>Grevillea "Caboolture"</b>	Caboolture	200mm \$25.00	Medium to large bushy shrub. Very fast growing and hardy, with showy salmon flowers for most of the year. Requires good drainage and full sun. Attracts birds. (Proteaceae)
<b>Grevillea "Honeycomb"</b>	Honeycomb	200mm \$25.00	Erect shrub naturally bushy with dense foliage to the ground. Cream flowers prolific in early spring attracting birds. Good screen plant for most areas except in areas with cold winters. (Proteaceae)

Name		Size/Price	Description
<b>Grevillea longistyla</b>	"Long John"	200mm \$25.00	Large fast growing shrub. Masses of crimson flowers for most of the year. Needs a well drained, sunny position. (Proteaceae)
<b>Gymnostoma australianum</b>	Daintree Pine	200mm \$35.00	Rare and ancient small tree with typical pine tree shape. Dense, bright green foliage. Does best in full sun. Makes a great Christmas Tree and tub plant. (Casuarinaceae)
<b>Laccospadix australasicus</b>	Atherton Palm	300mm \$50.00	Small suckering palm suitable for tub culture or moist shady position. Red fruit. Very slow growing. (Arecaceae)
<b>Leptospermum brachyandrum</b>	Silver Leafed Tea Tree	200mm \$19.90	Tall shrub to small tree with silvery new growth. The old bark peels off to reveal an attractive pink-purple trunk. (Myrtaceae)
<b>Leptospermum madidum (Northern Territory form)</b>	Weeping Tea Tree	200mm \$18.50	Large shrub with extremely attractive weeping form. Beautiful lime green foliage and a stunning smooth white trunk. Best in warm, wet climates. Must have lots of water. (Myrtaceae)
<b>Maniltoa lenticellata</b>	Cascading Bean	200mm \$35.00	Highly ornamental small tree with very spectacular, cascading pink new growth. Fluffy white balls of flowers. Quite hardy. Protect from wind. (Fabaceae)
<b>Medinilla balls-headleyi</b>	Daintree Medinilla	200mm \$40.00	Scrambling or semi-prostrate shrub with beautiful pale pink flowers and psychedelic pink fruit. Makes a lovely hanging basket specimen. (Melastomataceae)
<b>Musgravea heterophylla</b>	Briar Silky Oak	200mm \$45.00	Fairly slow growing but very beautiful plant with spectacular foliage. Huge leaves are deeply lobed when young. Needs humid protected position. (Proteaceae)
<b>Neorites kevediana</b>	Fishtail Oak	200mm \$19.90	Beautiful medium sized tree with extremely attractive, long pinnate leaves and deep maroon new growth. Cream flowers in terminal spikes. Not suitable for dry inland areas. Makes a great tub plant. (Proteaceae)
<b>Phaius tancarvilleae</b>	Swamp Orchid	200mm \$40.00	Extremely rare ground-orchid with large spikes of spectacular flowers. Best planted in a damp, fairly sunny spot in the garden, however can be kept in a large container in a bush house. Authorised Propagator Qld. No. APQF198/000050. (Orchidaceae)
<b>Pleomele angustifolia</b>	Native Dracaena	200mm \$25.00	Tall shrub with long rambling canes, white flowers and orange berries. An interesting alternative to the exotic dracaenas. (Dracaenaceae)

<b>Randia fitzalanii</b>	Brown Gardenia	200mm \$19.90	Medium to large shrub with large stiff dark green leaves and attractive white perfumed flowers. (Rubiaceae)
<b>Syzygium "Pink Willy"</b>	Pink Willy	200mm \$25.00	Shrub to about 2 metres high. Best in light shade in a well-tended situation. Fluffy pale pink flowers attract honeyeaters. Brilliant bright pink new growth. Excellent courtyard plant. (Myrtaceae)
<b>Syzygium australe</b>	Creek Satinash	200mm \$19.90	Large shrub to small tree. Bushy and hardy. Ideal as a screen plant. Masses of white flowers followed by edible pink fruit. (Myrtaceae)
<b>Syzygium australe "N. Qld Bushy Form"</b>	Creek Satinash (NQ Bushy Form)	200mm \$19.90	Bushy shrub with masses of white, fluffy flowers followed by edible pink fruit. Ideal for use as a screen plant. Suitable for most areas. (Myrtaceae)
<b>Syzygium australe Sth. QLD form</b>	Creek Satinash SQ Form	200mm \$19.90	Medium to large, dense shrub with masses of white, fluffy flowers followed by edible pink fruit. Ideal for use as a small screen plant. Suitable for most areas. (Myrtaceae)
<b>Syzygium monimioides</b>	Red Myrtle	300mm \$45.00	Very rare plant. Spectacular tree with brilliant red new growth and red flaky bark. (Myrtaceae)
<b>Terminalia catappa</b>	Sea Almond	200mm \$25.00	Attractive spreading tree with layered form and large leaves which assume autumn colour before shedding. Large fruit contain edible nuts. Ideal for beach plantings. (Combretaceae)
<b>Xanthorrhoea sp.</b>	Grass Tree	\$80.00+	Slow growing plant with a dense tuft of narrow spiky leaves, which eventually develops a trunk. Flowers on a long vertical stalk. Ideal feature plant for native gardens or in containers. Plant in well drained soil. (Xanthorrhoeaceae)
<b>Xanthostemon verticillatus</b>	Bloomfield Penda	200mm \$25.00	Dense shrub with large heads of fluffy cream-white flowers. A very attractive plant. Excellent in the garden or as a tub plant. (Myrtaceae)
